Garden Guidelines:

- Garden plots will be approximately 50 square feet and distributed on a first come basis.
- Every season, a 'Garden Coordinator' will be selected from the interested community gardeners to help manage the garden.
- The Garden Coordinator will be responsible for ensuring every garden plot is maintained to the highest degree possible.
- Every gardener is responsible for the upkeep of their own garden plot.
- Organic gardening techniques should be used at all times.
- Tools supplied for the community garden should be kept on site and kept in good working order.
- Water should be treated as a precious commodity and conserved as much as possible.
- Seeds and compost will be supplied by Jones Valley Urban Farm when ever possible. All other farm resources must be left for the use of JVUF staff and students.
